Week of March 29

Monday: Fellowship with Family Activity - Bouncing Balloons

This is a "yo-yo" type activity that is a fun hand eye coordination challenge – for both your child and you!



Materials: Multi colored balloons Play dough, sand or flour Scissors Large rubber band or multiple small bands Masking tape

Directions:

- 1. Fill the balloon with the play dough, sand or flour. Then tie the balloon shut.
- 2. Cut some small holes into a second balloon. Carefully stretch the second balloon over the play dough-filled balloon, allowing the color of the lower balloon to peek through the top layer holes.
- 3. Tie the rubber band around the knot in the balloon. If your rubber band is not long enough, make a "string" of bands by tying them to each other.

4. To play, draw an X on the floor with tape and use it as a target. Try to bounce the yo-yo on the object to see how many times you can bounce it.

Modifications for Younger Kids:

Skip the rubber bands and game. Let the kids squish the filled yo-yo ball

Modifications for Older Kids:

Set up a series of numbered X's on the floor in random pattern and instruct the child to work through the numbers in sequence. Each time an incorrect number is hit, the game starts over at the number one.
